

Recorded May 1993 at Scott AFB, Illinois. Master tapes produced at the studios of the Air Mobility Command Band were recorded in an analog format using Dolby SR Noise Reduction on an Otari MX-80 32 track recorder. The final product was mixed to 1/2 track with Dolby SR then digitally mastered.
