Since its formation in 1941, the Tactical Air Command Band has been recognized as one of the world's premier military bands. This 45-member organization has earned international praise by performing the finest music, commissioning and premiering new works, and producing critically acclaimed recordings. Public recognition from mayors, governors, and senators, demonstrates the band's significant contributions to the cultural and recreational climate throughout the Mid-Atlantic coastal region.

In 1988 the band became the first recipient of *The Colonel George S. Howard Citation of Musical Excellence for Military Concert Bands*, "having demonstrated particularly significant high standards of excellence in concert band performance." The TAC Band entertains over one-half million people annually giving its audiences the pleasure of hearing a military band proud of its tradition which represents the finest Air Force in the world.

MAJOR LOWELL E. GRAHAM COMMANDER/CONDUCTOR

Major Lowell E. Graham has earned worldwide recognition as one of the most talented conductors in the United States Air Force music program. A native of Greeley, Colorado, he holds a Bachelor's Degree in Music Education and a Master's Degree in Music Performance from the University of Northern Colorado. He also holds a Doctor of Musical Arts Degree in Orchestral Conducting from the Catholic University of America.

Prior to his assignment as Commander/Conductor of the Tactical Air Command Band, Major Graham served as Commander/Conductor of the Air Force Band of the Golden Gate at Travis Air Force Base, California; Director of the Air Force Strings/Assistant Conductor of the Air Force Band at Bolling Air Force Base, Washington DC; and as Deputy Commander/Assistant Conductor of the Air Force Band of the West at Lackland Air Force Base, Texas.
